Rechargeable handle now with charge status display.

HEINE NT300[®] Charger

Instruments powered by rechargeable batteries are nothing new in doctors' practices. However, there is one groundbreaking innovation in this area: HEINE has launched the first rechargeable handle with a charge status display. From now on, physicians can see how much energy remains in the handle. Interruptions during examination are now a thing of the past for the doctor and patient.

Time savings and comfort included: the HEINE NT300[®] Charger is perfectly-matched to the rechargeable handle and is able to completely recharge in just two hours. The instrument automatically switches off when it is placed in the charging compartment. It switches back on when the physician picks it up again – at the preset brightness level. It makes no difference how often or for how long instruments are placed in the charger. There is no memory effect. One more advantage makes the system even more economical: doctors' practices save valuable time every day as a result of the improved hygienic design of the handle.

HEINE has, of course, also considered physicians who already work with BETA handles. These handles can be easily converted. Any HEINE BETA[®] 3.5 V handle can be updated with a charge status display.
